



## SELF REVIEW PROCEDURES

Self Review is an ongoing process that involves preparing, gathering information, and making sense of that information in order to find out what is working well and what needs to be undertaken to improve our practice and impact positively on children's learning. Self review includes both formal and informal processes. Informal self review may become formal when time is required to gather more information and consider other perspectives. Informal reviews will be integrated into existing systems, e.g. daily diary, staff meetings etc.
